Brookside Gardens is an award-winning 50-acre public display garden including the zalea garden, rose garden, children's garden, formal garden, fragrance garden, Japanese style garden and trial garden.

Go Ape! is a treetop adventure course featuring zip lines and obstacle courses, perfect for a corporate retreat or family fun. The first U.S. location opened in Rock Creek Regional Park in Rockville.

The AFI Silver Theatre and Cultural Center is a state-of-the-art moving image exhibition, education and cultural center housing two stadium theatres, office and meeting space, and reception and exhibit areas. AFI is the home of Silverdocs, a seven day internationally renowned film festival that celebrates independent thinking and generates global media attention.

The Music Center at Strathmore. This magnificent structure houses 1,978-seat concert hall which welcomes world renowned performers. The connecting state-of-the-art education center features music and dance classes, workshops, and seminars for all ages.

Heritage Tourism: With a history stretching beyond Colonial times, Montgomery County has a long heritage evidenced by rich cultural and historical resources. The Heritage Tourism Alliance of Montgomery County (Heritage Montgomery) is an initiative created by county leaders and state officials to raise the profile of the area's heritage, ensuring that residents and visitors alike understand and value the county's full past.

C&O Canal National Historical Park. Heritage of the Potomac River with walking towpath to the Olmstead Bridges overlooking Great Falls.

Sugarloaf Mountain Vineyard, a 92-acre farm nestled in the rolling hills of Comus, Maryland, is the only winery in Montgomery County, Maryland. The winery welcomes visitors for wine tastings, tours of the vineyard, and various events throughout the year.
